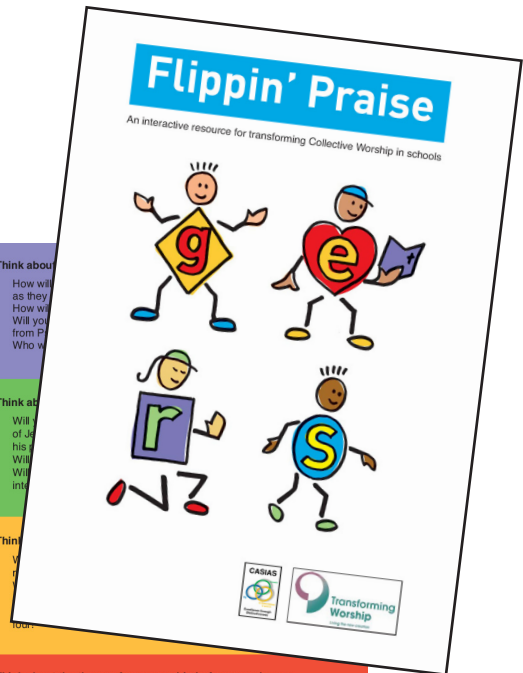


Sending:
